Instructions:

- 1. You must complete the entire application to have your program considered for the AIFD National Symposium in Washington DC. Submission deadline is **December 15, 2016**
- 2. For proposals featuring more than one presenter, each proposed presenter must sign a submission form.
- 3. You must submit a 5-10 minute video*, introducing yourself and describing your program concept and details. If multiple people will be presenting a video including all individuals must be submitted.

The AIFD Program Standard

Every program presented at AIFD National Symposium **<u>MUST</u>** have education as its first priority.

To that end here are the guidelines:

- Education over ego.
- A tone- setting opening that introduces the subject.
- A logical flow of designs and content.
- Commentary that explains the work that was created and techniques used and proper floral references.
- Content should be focused on teaching something to the audience. The program is not about what the presenter can do but how the audience can do what is being shown.
- There must be at least one live design demonstration* on stage.
- A climatic ending.
- Proper attire that expresses a professional image.
- Absolutely no profanity or obscenities.
- Three to five natural references (by name or product) of the program's underwriter(s).
- Respect for the products provided by the sponsors.
- A strict adherence to the guidelines, budgets and contracts for the individual program and the AIFD National Symposium.
