



Covid-19 Protocol Update for AIFD® 2022 ROOTS National Symposium (as of 6/21/22)

As of June 20, AIFD® is excited to share that preparations for Las Vegas are well underway. At this time, the state of Nevada and Clark County Government, which includes Las Vegas, are not requiring masks at indoor, or outdoor facilities. However, people may choose to mask at any time. To limit exposure and maintain the health of all Symposium attendees we request that people with symptoms of COVID-19 or a positive COVID-19 test refrain from attending Symposium. If you think you have had exposed to COVID-19 please review the U.S. Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) guidelines.

The CDC has created a COVID-19 County Check site for individuals to review community COVID levels and preventions steps they can take to protect themselves. The information is updated weekly at [cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov). Enter "Nevada" as the state and "Clark" as the county to view the latest CDC recommendations for protecting yourself while attending the ROOTS Symposium in Las Vegas. AIFD® has taken the following health and safety precautions to protect attendees and staff during symposium.

- In compliance with local guidelines, employees shall wear masks.
- The registration desk is arranged to allow for appropriate social distancing.
- High touch items at the registration desk are cleaned frequently.
- Hand sanitizer and masks will be provided near the registration desk.
- Social distancing may be observed during Main Stage programs by attendees by sitting every-other-seat

- Guest deliveries will be dropped off outside the guest room door if the room is occupied
- Team Members will provide hand sanitizer at check-in, table games, cage, and other transaction points.
- Hand washing reminders are available throughout restroom facilities.
- Social distancing procedures are implemented in compliance with local guidelines.
