The Youth involved in the Future Farmers of America Floriculture program

The American Institute of Floral Designers® (AIFD®) will host 16 students and 4 instructors for the FFA Initiative. This would allow for 4 teams (4 students per team and 1 advisor) to attend the AIFD® 2024 Symposium National - Monday, July 1 – Friday, July 5, 2023 in Orlando, FL.

Each team of 4 students and one instructor will receive \$2,500. \$500.00 scholarship per person will be given to each to be split in this way:

- * \$250.00 will go to AIFD®/FFA registration that will cover the AIFD® Workshops and Event plus AIFD®/FFA program expenses.
- * \$250.00

\$200 per night allowance for an estimated one-night hotel room at the Hilton Orlando Bonnet Creek, 14100 Bonnet Creek Resort Lane, Orlando, FL 32831-1023 \$50.00 per person for travel/food expenses.

The date for the team selections will be selected by or before March 15, 2024
