Recipients shall be known as 'Fellows of AIFD®' and are granted Life Membership.








### North East on the Main Stage

special event.










## "WORK TRIP" BY TRISH REPPERT CFD

I arrived in Chicago a few days before the AIFD Grow Symposium began, and when anyone, from the airport attendant to the Uber driver, asked why I was in Chicago, I always replied, "Work trip." But they probably didn't catch my smile when I said it. They may have felt sorry for me, that I had to "work" all week. Don't get me wrong—the whole reason I was there early was that I had registered as an AIFD Ambassador. This was my 2nd symposium, and my 2nd year attending as an Ambassador, so I knew there would be work. As an Ambassador, you are assigned to assist where needed. This could be processing flowers, cleaning buckets, filling buckets, carrying buckets, pulling flowers, pushing carts, moving pallets, etc. (a.k.a. "Work"). But I also knew that the work brought with it some amazing opportunities.







Florists and other AIFD Partners attend symposium to connect or reconnect with floral friends and industry leaders. There is no better place to connect than through the Ambassador program. First of all, you are on a team with 35 other Ambassadors, and often assigned to the same tasks. Unpacking and chopping 1,000 flowers next to one another creates some fast friends! In addition, you often will be assigned to one of the main stage designers. You may get to meet and work side by side some of the best designers in the world! You have an All-Access, backstage pass to see the designer's vision come to life from the beginning, right through to their main stage presentations. Sometimes, you are working on the more time-consuming tasks, such as wrapping hundreds of pieces of floral material in wire, weaving ribbon, or pinning a thousand flower heads to some surface! Other times, the designer will show you a technique, and ask you to complete a design task. Either way, it's like attending a master's class! We often see these internationally known designers and may be intimidated to speak with them. As an Ambassador, they welcome your volunteerism as a vital part of their presentation. They often show their kindness and appreciation by taking time to demonstrate their methods and make your time there a learning experience. And they warmly smile next to you for selfies!

During breaks, you may attend the programs and stage presentations taking place at the time, so you can share those experiences with other AIFD attendees. I recommend going through the gallery of previous days' event designs should you miss any program you were interested in. In addition, try to attend the Partners' Showcase, and introduce yourself to the various industry vendors. There are committee meetings and informal gatherings listed on the event app where you can make even more connections!







And let's not forget the nightlife! As an Ambassador, and in appreciation of your hard work, you are given a ticket to the Awards and Induction Dinner Dance, as part of your already reduced price registration. You are also invited to attend the Welcome Reception and all cocktail hours, where you can strengthen the connections you have been making. Tickets are available to join in the last evening's gala, and this year, the Ambassadors were given a special treat. An anonymous donor bought tickets for all Ambassadors to attend! It was a Versailles themed masquerade ball, but we could not mask our surprise or enthusiasm!
